

## **Level III Expected Behavioral Outcomes**

### **Medical Prescribers (MD/DO, PA, NP)**

- Conduct an HIV risk assessment
- Conduct and/or recommend HIV testing for patients who are at risk
- Routinely offer HIV testing for pregnant women
- Identify signs and symptoms of HIV disease
- Identify and treat opportunistic infections
- Administer treatment for post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP)
- Perform risk reduction counseling, particularly with at-risk and HIV-infected patients
- Identify and/or access appropriate referral and consultation resources
- Identify at least 4 STD tests routinely recommended for HIV-infected patients
- Provide primary care and meet routine health needs of HIV-infected patients
- Provide treatment options for HIV-infected patients
- Describe benefits of rapid testing

### **Nurses (RN, LPN, LVN)**

- Provide prevention education, particularly with at-risk and HIV-infected patients
- Conduct an HIV risk assessment
- Conduct and/or recommend HIV testing for patients who are at risk
- Identify signs and symptoms of HIV
- Monitor adherence to medications
- Promote adherence to treatment and medication regimens
- Identify and/or access appropriate referral and consultation resources

### **Dental Health Professionals (DDS/DMD, RDH)**

- Identify signs and symptoms of HIV disease
- Conduct an HIV risk assessment
- Conduct and/or recommend HIV testing of patients who are at risk
- Identify and/or access appropriate referral and consultation resources
- Recommend treatment for post-exposure prophylaxis
- Provide routine prophylactic services to HIV-infected clients
- Identify clinical manifestations of HIV

### **Pharmacists (PharmD, RPh)**

- Identify potential drug-drug interactions for clinicians/patients
- Provide risk/benefit information for clinicians/patients about HIV drugs
- Inform clinicians/patients about side effects of HIV drugs
- Intercept and consult with prescriber inappropriate dosages for HIV drugs, especially orders for monotherapy and contraindicated combinations.
- Promote adherence to treatment and medication regimens
- Identify and/or access appropriate referral and consultation resources

### **Mental Health and Case Management**

- Conduct an HIV risk assessment
- Conduct and/or recommend HIV testing of clients who are at risk
- Monitor adherence to treatment protocols/inform clinician of problems
- Provide risk reduction counseling, particularly with at-risk and HIV-infected patients
- Identify resources available for HIV-infected clients/network
- Identify and/or access appropriate referral and consultation resources
